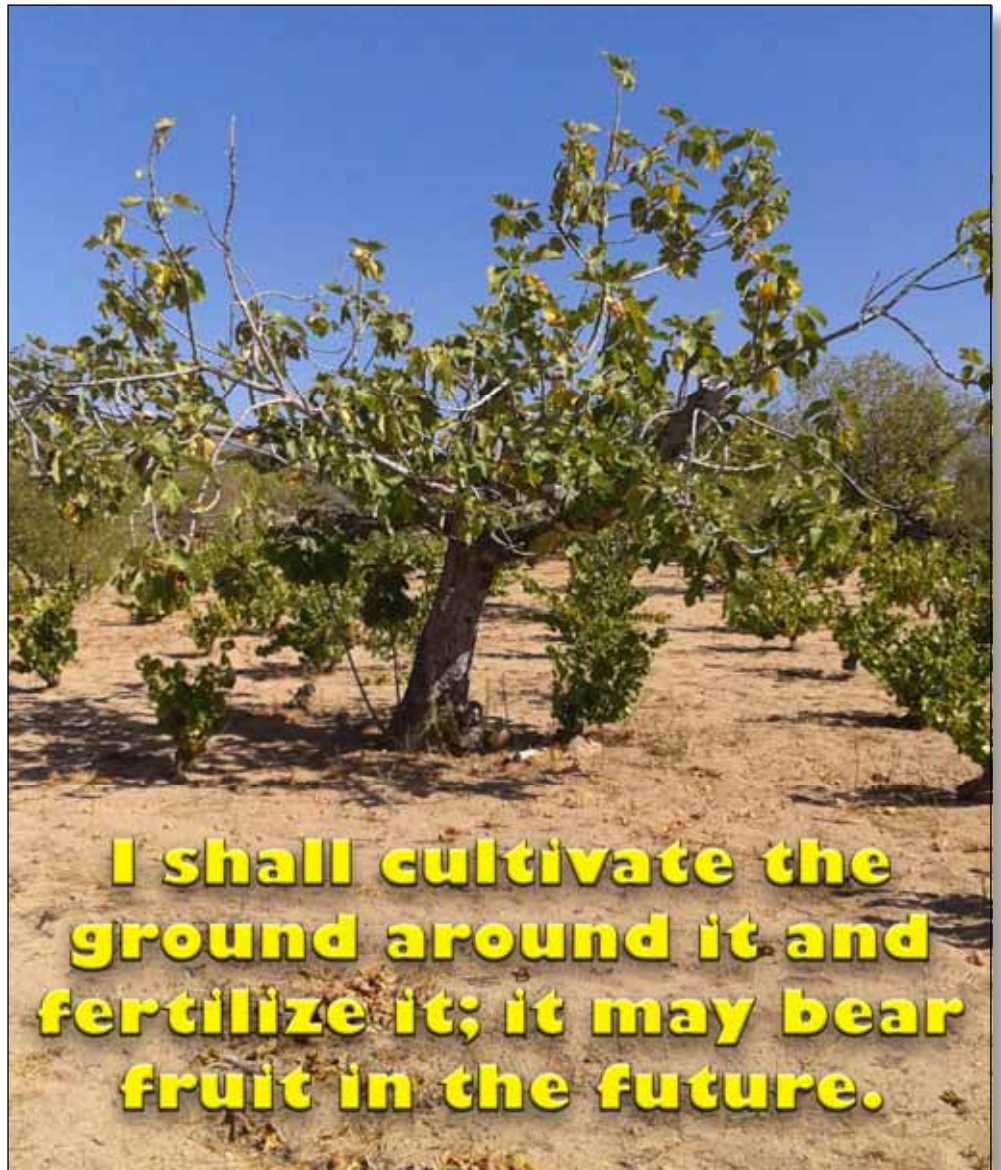

## The Annunciation

Tomorrow, March 25, is the Solemnity of the Annunciation, observed nine months before Christmas Day. On this major feast the penitential season of Lent pauses for a day of joyful celebration, setting aside the purple of Lent for the glory of white vestments.

Catholics reflect on the Annunciation when praying the first of the joyful mysteries of the rosary, which fittingly begins those happy events of our salvation: the Visitation, the Nativity, the Presentation, and the finding of the Christ Child in the temple.

When the angel appeared to Mary and told her that she was chosen to be the mother of the Messiah, she could have refused the embarrassment of an unexplained pregnancy. Yet St. Augustine wrote, "The patriarchs, the prophets, and all people are waiting for the promised Savior. Hurry up, Mary, and say, 'Yes.'"

The early church saw in Mary's "Yes" to the angel a reversal of Eve's "No" in the Garden of Eden. As St. Paul found a contrast of Adam with Christ, the first Christians saw a similar opposition of Eve and Mary. St. Irenaeus wrote, "If Eve was disobedient and became both for herself and all the human race the path to death, Mary through her obedience became, both for herself and all the faithful, the path to salvation."

That gift of grace from Mary and Christ reversed the loss of grace by Eve and Adam. St. Irenaeus wrote, "The knot that Eve's disobedience had tied was untied by Mary's obedience; what Eve had bound by her unbelief, Mary unbound by her faith." *Mary the Untier of Knots*, a painting by Johann Schmittner shown here, captures this message of the Annunciation. It is also symbolic of Mary's intercession which helps us unravel the difficulties of our own lives.

This faith of the early Church has endured through the centuries. Pope John Paul II in his encyclical *Mother of the Redeemer* saw all of salvation history, from the Fall to the Final Judgment, reflected in the Eve-Mary relationship. He wrote, "Mary is the companion of all the faithful on their pilgrimage of faith distorted by the first Eve but reoriented by Mary, the New Eve. The first Eve doubted; the new Eve believed."

In our age where doubt appears more readily than trust, where selfishness too often hinders charity, this feast of the Annunciation of the Angel to Mary calls us back to the generous and joyful faith of our church.

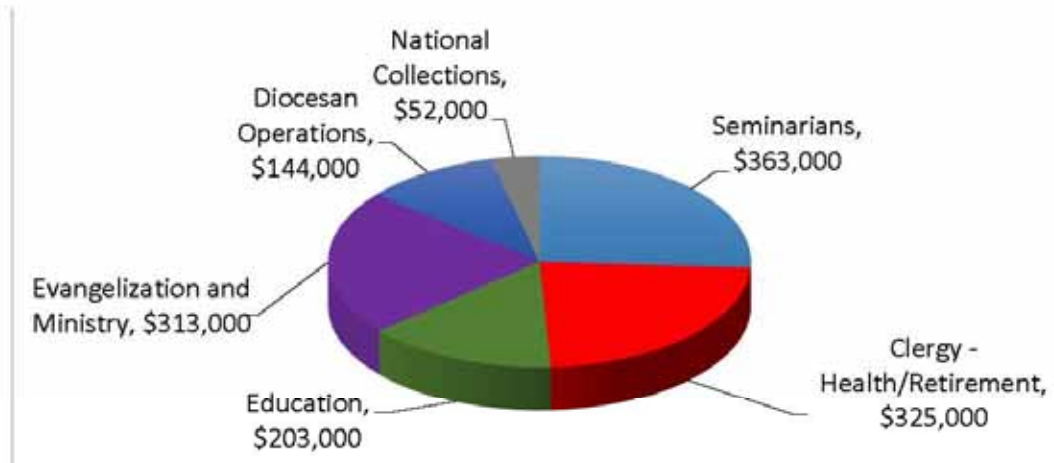
