The **Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy** is being observed from the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, 2015, to the Feast of Christ the King, 2016, as a period for the remission of sins and universal pardon focusing particularly on God's forgiveness and mercy. It is the 27th holy year in the history of the church. The opening day was the fiftieth anniversary of the closing of the Second Vatican Council.

Pope Francis wishes the Jubilee to be celebrated not only in Rome but all around the world. For the first time in Jubilee Year the holy doors will be opened in each individual diocese at the main cathedral and also at local historical churches such as our own St. Fidelis Basilica, the Cathedral of the Plains.

The Jubilee of Mercy was formally declared through the papal decree *Misericordiae Vultus* (The Face of Mercy), issued on April 11, 2015, which emphasizes the importance of mercy and the need to "gaze" on it. The decree also recalls the need for the Church to be more open, keeping alive the spirit of the Second Vatican Council.

The holy doors of the major basilicas of Rome were opened first, and then the special "Doors of Mercy" were opened at cathedrals and other major churches around the world. The opening of the holy door at St Peter's was the first time two popes were present, as Pontiff Emeritus Benedict attended at Pope Francis' invitation.

By passing through the holy doors, the faithful can earn indulgences after fulfilling the usual conditions of prayer for the Pope's intentions, confession, and communion. During Lent of this year, special penance services will be celebrated, and during the year, specially delegated priests called "Missionaries of Mercy" will be available in every diocese to forgive sins normally reserved to the Holy See's Apostolic Penitentiary. In the decree proclaiming this year of mercy, Pope Francis said about the opening of the holy door, "the Holy Door will become a Door of Mercy through which anyone who enters will experience the love of God who consoles, pardons, and instills hope."

- December 8, 2015: opening of the holy door in St. Peter's Basilica
- December 13, 2015: opening of the holy door of the Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls, and in many other cathedrals around the world
- January 1, 2016: opening of the holy door of Santa Maria Majora
- January 19–21, 2016: Jubilee for the pilgrims
- February 2, 2016: closing of the "Year for Consecrated Life"
- February 22, 2016: Jubilee for the Roman Curia
- March 4–5, 2016: penitential liturgies calling for God's mercy
- April 24, 2016: Jubilee for newly confirmed aged 13–16
- May 27–29, 2016: Jubilee for deacons
- June 3, 2016: Jubilee for priests
- June 12, 2016: Jubilee for diseased people and those who assist them
- July 26–31, 2016: Jubilee for young people in Kraków, Poland
- September 4, 2016: Jubilee for volunteers
- September 25, 2016: Jubilee for catechists
- October 8–9, 2016: Marian Jubilee
- November 6, 2016: Jubilee for prisoners in St. Peter's Basilica
- November 13, 2016: closing of holy doors outside St. Peter's Basilica
- November 20, 2016: closing of the holy door in St. Peter's Basilica
