ASH WEDNESDAY—MARCH 1

Lent is a time of grace and renewal for the entire Church, especially for the catechumens and candidates preparing for initiation during the Easter Triduum. The three traditional ascetical practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are important pillars for a faithful experience of Lent. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting (for those 14 through 59) and abstinence (for those 14 and over). The Fridays of Lent remain days of abstinence.

Lent begins this week on *Ash Wednesday*. The penitential season of Lent is often welcomed reluctantly. But the final day before Lent, *Mardi Gras*, is more than welcome, especially in our secular culture. *Mardi Gras* is party time, one last fling, a day of merriment. Christianity has no difficulty with festivity. However, the original name for the Tuesday before Lent was not *Mardi Gras*, but *Shrove Tuesday*. A balanced preparation for Lent should reflect on both titles – *Mardi Gras* and *Shrove Tuesday*.

Mardi Gras, literally, “Fat Tuesday,” implies excess and indulgence. The origin of the term is something quite different. Originally, in a time before refrigeration, the day before Lent was the day to clean out the pantry of food that was forbidden during Lent. Since it might spoil in storage during the forty days of Lenten fasting it had to be consumed on the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday. So the final day before Lent became Fat Tuesday. Items like pancakes and doughnuts and funnel cakes were popular on the last day before Lent, hence such festivities as the Pancake Race.

Modern society has turned that quite around. Today we don't empty our pantry, we fill it. We don't use up old supplies; we shop for *Mardi Gras* specials. We are not planning for the coming Lent. We are indulging in the present moment.

Shrove Tuesday, the earlier name for the final day before Lent, can help to put a proper perspective on *Mardi Gras*. Perhaps it may even correct our tendency to excess. *Shrove Tuesday* literally means Confession Tuesday. “To shrive” means to confess one's sins in the Sacrament of Penance. “To be shriven” means to be absolved of one's sins by a priest. *Shrove Tuesday* is the day to go to confession and accept the penance that you will do for Lent to atone for your sins. All three days before Lent—Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday—are known as *Shrovetide*, a time to reflect on our moral weakness and determine what Lenten penance would best atone for our failings and strengthen our spirit.

Acknowledging our weakness is the first necessary step in determining what Lenten observance is best for our spiritual development. Proper planning is every bit as important as faithful observance. But human nature tends to avoid a serious confrontation. Unfortunately it is easier to wait and see what Lent brings, to take it as it comes. But if one does, then suddenly it is Palm Sunday and we really haven't done much of anything for Lent.

The purpose of *Shrove Tuesday*, as well as *Mardi Gras* rightly observed, is to avoid such an aimless Lent. These days are an opportunity to determine how effective your Lent will be. Don't wait till Ash Wednesday. *Mari Gras*, Fat Tuesday, is the day to clean out your pantry. *Shrove Tuesday*, Confession Tuesday, is the day to clean out the pantry of your soul, to acknowledge that sinfulness has cluttered your spiritual life, and to determine a remedy of effective Lenten penance.

Enjoy a festive *Mardi Gras* with a moderation that brings a simple happiness rather than an excess with its regretful hangover. But also find a few quiet moments for the sober reflection of *Shrove Tuesday*. A welcomed Lent, committed to the Christian paradox of joyful penance, is a special gift of God's grace.
