“I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die.”



(from the Holy Gospel according to John 11:1-45)



All the other miracles of Christ pale in comparison with his power to raise the dead to life. There are three occasions in the gospels when Christ raised a dead person to life: the son of the widow of Nain, the daughter of Jairus, and in today's gospel Lazarus, the brother of Mary and Martha. Besides these three specific individuals, the gospels refer to "raising the dead" as part of the ministry of Christ and his disciples.

The meaning of Christ raising the dead to life was not that a fortunate few were returned to life for a short time, only to die again later. The message is that Christ offers us a share in the life of God, a life that does not end. It is the promise of life eternal.

The raising of Lazarus occurs in the gospel of John which never uses the word *miracle*. The other gospels refer to the wondrous deeds of Christ as miracles but John uses the term *sign*. There are seven such *signs*: curing the official's son; healing the paralyzed man; feeding the five thousand; walking on water; giving sight to the man born blind, and the climactic seventh sign is today's gospel, the raising of Lazarus from the dead.

The term *sign* indicates that these wondrous deeds are not in themselves the full message, but that they are pointing to, depicting, reflecting, imaging a deeper spiritual message. They are material images of a spiritual reality. The *sign* of Lazarus returning to a life where he would later die again, is pointing to a source of life that does not end. As Jesus said on that occasion, "I am the resurrection and the life, whoever believes in me though he shall die will come to life: and whoever is alive and believes in me will never die." That is the most profound promise of the gospels, to which Martha, speaking for all the faithful, replied, "Lord, I have come to believe that you are the Messiah, the Son of God, He who is to come into the world."

Cynics, misreading this gospel, might object that if Jesus truly were the compassionate Son of God he would have raised all the dead to life. They are mistaken, but not entirely, because all the dead will rise. The mission of Christ was not to alter our human condition, but to teach us to follow his path through this human life to eternal life with the Father. The message of the Lazarus story is the bedrock of Christianity — life eternal.

Restoring Lazarus to earthly life is a *sign* pointing beyond that singular event to this spiritual message: "I am the resurrection and the life, whoever believes in me though he shall die will come to life: and whoever is alive and believes in me will never die."

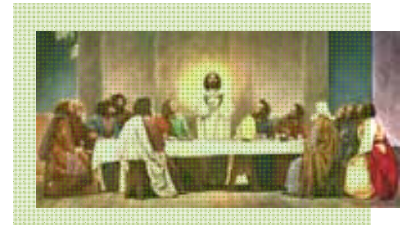

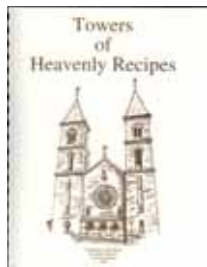
