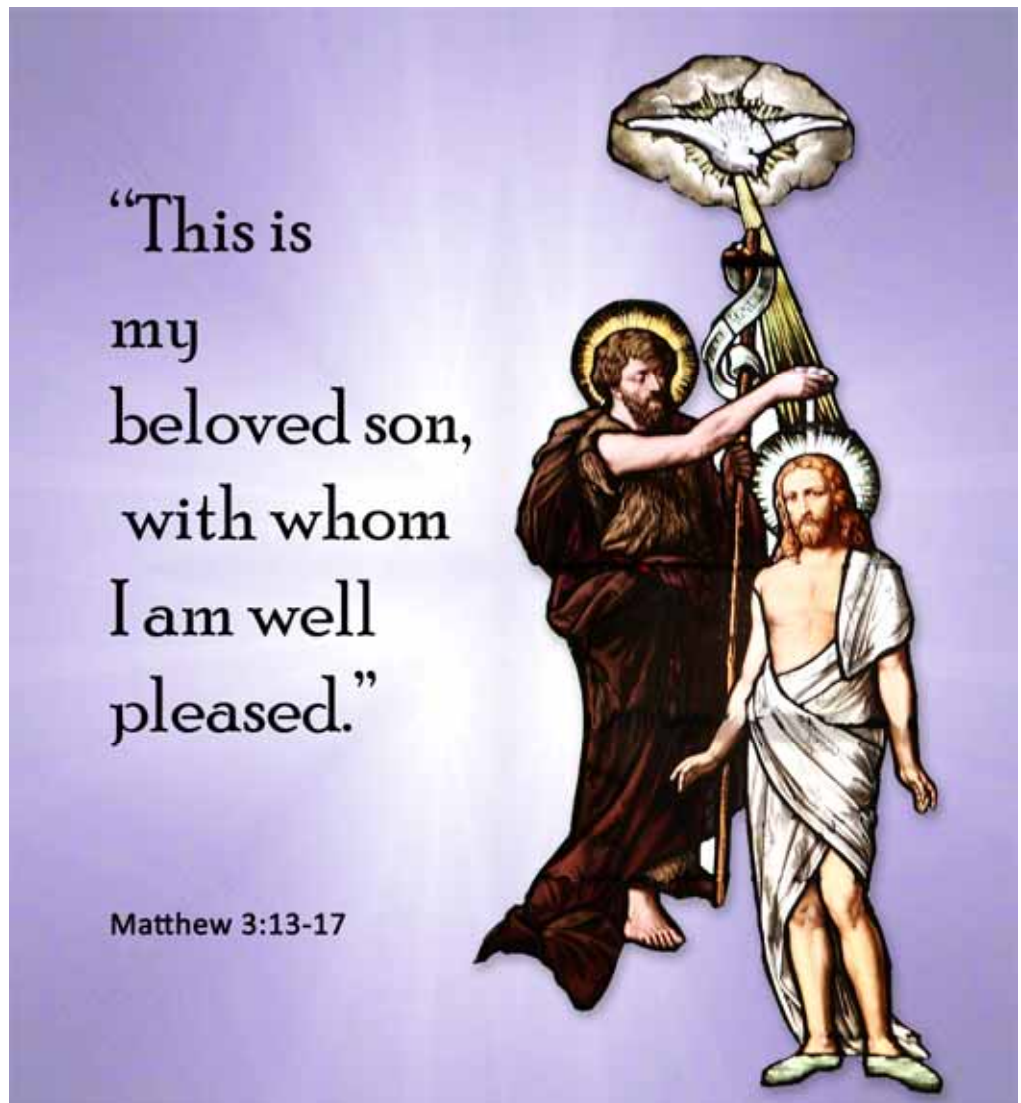

The Indelible Mark of Baptism

The famous artist Pablo Picasso was once sunning himself on a beach in France. A woman recognized him and sent her little boy to him with a piece of paper hoping for a sketch or his autograph. Picasso was familiar with attempts to pilfer his artistic work. So he tore up the paper, drew an artistic design on the little boy's chest, and said, "Tell your mother that she can never wash you again."

Baptism marks us indelibly in the image of Christ. The baptism of the Lord was different from our baptism. Christ was sinless without need of baptismal cleansing. Yet in one sense the baptism of Christ is similar to our baptism. At the baptism of Jesus, God the Father said, "You are my beloved Son, with you I am well pleased."

By baptism we have been marked as children of God, in the image of Christ. That mark is indelible. You are forever a Christian, whether you live like one or not. Even if others do not see Christ in you, God the Father always sees the image of his Son in those who are baptized. The words spoken by God the Father regarding Christ apply analogously to all who are baptized, "You are my child; with you I am well pleased." By baptism we are children of God in the image of Christ, the Father's own divine son.

At the baptismal ceremony parents are asked, "What do you wish for your child?" Parents wish for many things: health and happiness, peace and

prosperity. These are good wishes, but not the wish at baptism. By presenting your child for baptism you declare your deepest wish – that this child will live not only as a child of your family, but also as a child of God. You declare your hope that your child will be enriched by faith, and live always in God's grace.

And you wish for something greater than these. The ultimate Christian wish is for life eternal. At baptism the mother is blessed, "This mother now thanks God for the gift of her child as she sees the hope of eternal life shine on this child. May she be one with her child in thanking God forever in heaven."

That boy who was a canvas for Picasso eventually took a bath and was no longer his work of art. But if he had been baptized, he became a child of God, indelibly marked with the image of Christ, throughout this life into life eternal.
