Carpe Diem

Commercials for next week's Super Bowl often get as much hype as the game itself. The cost of those commercials is staggering. This year it is \$5.25 million for 30 seconds, \$10.5 million for one minute! Does anyone have a message worth that kind of cash?

Jesus
began to preach,
and to say,
Repent:
for the
kingdom of heaven
is at hand.

Matthew 4:17

If Jesus of Nazareth were given such a 30 second spot, what would he say to that large audience? Some might suggest, "You shall love God with all your heart and your neighbor as yourself." Good answer. Perhaps, "Whatever you do to the least of my children that you do to me." Or more challenging, "Love your enemy." All good answers. But all wrong – according to scripture scholars.

The majority of scripture scholars think that if Jesus returned to earth he would repeat the key verse in today's gospel, "Repent, for the kingdom of Heaven is at hand." That was also the message of John the Baptist and the prophets of the Old Testament. It is the essential requirement of both covenants.

If you are puzzled, a verbal analysis might help. **Repent** means much more than converting from a life of sin to a life of grace. It means continual growth in your faith. **Repent** means a conversion that must happen everyday. You cannot live today with yesterday's faith.

The kingdom of Heaven is one of the most important but also a very difficult concept of the gospels. It defies a complete definition. We know what it is not. It is not a geographical or social structure. The kingdom of Heaven refers to the power of God acting in the world. The kingdom of Heaven is what God wills the world and his people to become. As we pray in the Lord's Prayer, "Thy kingdom come."

"Repent, for the kingdom of Heaven is at hand." Some view that as the threat of a deadline. A proper understanding of **at hand** is crucial to the message of Christ.

At hand is not a threat; it is a promise. It is not a deadline; it is an opportunity. The meaning of **at hand** is related to Christmas, to the Incarnation. God has become one of us, he has shared our nature, he is near to us.

At hand can also be translated as *near, within, or among you*. All conveying the sense that grace is an opportunity not to be missed. A classic proverb says, "Carpe diem." *Repent, for the kingdom of Heaven is at hand*. You cannot live today with yesterday's faith.

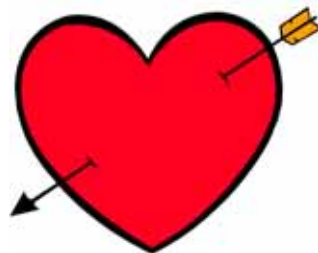
