On Labor Day, Monday, September 1, Mass will be at 9:00 a.m. at The Basilica of St. Fidelis. There will be no 7:00 p.m. Mass. and no scheduled Confessions.

> Seed Wheat will be blessed after all Masses the weekend of September 6-7.



Monday is Labor Day. On Labor Day, paradoxically, we do not labor. But we engage in the most difficult aspect of labor, we search for its meaning. Our modern culture concentrates on the social and economic dimensions of work, seldom reflecting on the spiritual meaning of our labors.

Christians work not only for financial security and personal fulfillment, but also as an expression of our faith. Work was an integral part of the life and message of Christ. He was the Good Shepherd, a laborer. He was known as "the carpenter's son." For his apostles he chose not churchmen but fisherman. And most of his parables are about daily work, farming and fishing, herding and housekeeping.

When Peter needed money for taxes, Jesus did not just hand it to him miraculously. Instead he told him to go catch a fish. When his disciples were discouraged by day of empty nets, he encouraged them to continue and "put out your nets into the deep." And Christ was disturbed by unemployment. Recall how the master of the vineyard went into the marketplace and said, "Don't stand here idle. Go into the vineyard and work."

Scripture reminds us that God does not work in the world apart from us. We are his stewards. He raises children through mothers and fathers. He heals through doctors and nurses. He imparts knowledge through teachers and tutors. He builds through carpenters and craftsmen. St. Theresa told their convent cook, "Christ moves among the pots and the pans." St. James wrote, "Faith without work is dead." Whatever your profession, you are laboring in the vineyard of the Lord.

Christ also taught that work is not the be-all and end-all of life. He knew the importance of rest and renewal. He told his Apostles to come aside to an out of the way place and rest awhile. Christianity understands the paradox that on Labor Day we do not labor.

Christ taught that prayer was an integral part of the work of his Father. He went faithfully to the synagogue and temple to pray. The word "liturgy" means the "work of the people." Our participation in the prayer of the church, especially the Eucharist, is our most important work. We do not make our living by this work of prayer, but it is the work that gives meaning to our living.

If we labor only for material rewards, we miss a deeper dimension of our work. St. Paul wrote, "Whatever you do, work at it with your whole being. Do it for the Lord rather than for men, since you know full well that you will receive an inheritance from him as your reward."

# . . . . . and mirth

When Pope John XXIII gave the archbishop of Canterbury a tour of the Vatican, the archbishop was very impressed. "This is quite a large operation," he said, "How many people work here?" Pope John said, "About half of them."
