**I am the way
and
the truth
and
the life.**

**No one comes
to the Father except
through me.**

(from the Holy Gospel according to John 14:1-12)



"I am the way, and the truth, and the life." Those words of Christ in today's gospel are some of the most memorable of the New Testament. They are also among the most important. They offer a summary of the Christian faith; they are Christianity in a nutshell. For Christians, Christ is the way to salvation, the truth that we seek, and the source of life unending.

In saying that he is the Way and the Truth and the Life Jesus is telling us both what he does and what he is. The words and the works of Christ flow from his nature as the Son of the Father.

Therefore Christ is the Way and the Truth and the Life in a twofold sense: in respect to himself and in respect to his followers. In himself, Christ is the Way in that his relationship with the Father makes him the door to life with the Father; in reference to his followers, Christ is the Way in that his life shows the path to salvation. In himself, Christ the Truth in that he is the revelation of the Father who is truth itself; for his disciples Christ is the Truth in that his teachings offer the ultimate wisdom. In himself, Christ is the Life in that he shares the divine life of the Father; for Christians, Christ is the Life, in that he offers eternal life through faith in him.

These terms – the Way, the Truth, and the Life – have meaning not only individually, but also in their relationship with each other. Jesus is the Way and the Truth and the Life because the Way to the Father is the Truth of Christ and the destination of the Way is Life with the Father, which is the goal of our journey. The image of an old fashioned milking stool where the three legs form an integral unit may be helpful here. Neither the Way, nor the Truth, nor the Life, stands alone. The three are interrelated and mutually sustaining. There is also an analogy here with the Trinity. The Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit are one God. In a similar manner, the Way and the Truth and the Life form the one Christ.

The use of the definite article before each of the three terms – The Way, The Truth, The Life – is deliberate. It implies that Jesus is the only path to salvation, the ultimate truth, and life itself. When a person comes to Jesus for Truth and Life, it is not simply a matter of learning his Way and then going one's own way, as with other mentors. A Christian must remain in Christ. His disciples must journey on The Way while belonging to The Truth that they may arrive at The Life of the Father.

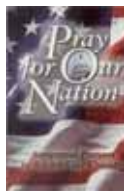
