Today the church celebrates, not the usual Sunday liturgy, but the feast of the dedication of the church of St. John Lateran. St. John Lateran is the church built by Constantine in the fourth century as the cathedral of the bishop of Rome. It is the mother church of all Christianity.

Scripture offers many thoughts on the meaning of a church. It is the meeting point of heaven and earth; it is the site for sacrifice, the place of forgiveness and atonement, the sign of the people's unity, the place of God's most intense presence. Christ said of the temple in Jerusalem, "My father's house is a house of prayer." In summary, a church is the house of God.

To say that a church is the house of God says that it is a holy place. To say that this house of God is our Father's house says that his sons and daughters are welcome in this holy place as our home. A church is not only a symbol that God exists, but that He lives in our midst and we are invited to visit Him.

In the Catholic tradition, we name our churches after saints. Saints are our big bothers and our big sisters in the family of God. Our Father's house is their house and our home. As we refer to grandma's house or uncle Joe's place or aunt Mary's home, we name our churches St. Joseph Church, St. Mary's Church, St. Fidelis Church. Our Father's house is the home for our family in faith.

A church is also a monument to our faith. It stands for the most important values in our lives. And it helps preserve those values. It is in church that we celebrate such values at the milestones of our lives. The parish church is where your parents brought you for baptism and where you brought them for burial. The church is where you made your First Holy Communion, and where you promised a holy communion with your spouse. It is where you caroled at Christmas and cried at funerals. When we visit the church where these milestones of our life were celebrated, our values of family and faith are remembered, relished, and renewed.

We have a popular expression, "If these walls could talk." If each of the buildings in our community says something, this church says that there is more to life than daily business, that faith guides and strengthens people through their trials, that God lives among us and that his house is our home.

The skyline of Rome is dominated by St. Peter's Basilica, the most famous church in the world. But St. John Lateran, the cathedral of the bishop of Rome, is the church with the most memories, the most meaning, and the most mystery, which is what we cherish in our own parish church, Saint Fidelis Basilica, the Cathedral of the Plains, one of the Eight Wonders of Kansas.

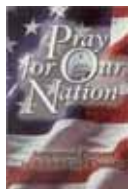
