# The Lord has truly been raised.

(from the Holy Gospel according to Mark 24:13-35)

**The Parish Office will be closed tomorrow Easter Monday, April 6**



In Goethe's Faust, a depressed Dr. Faust is contemplating suicide when he hears a church bell ring. It brings him to his senses, and he suddenly realizes that it is Easter morning. Church bells are ringing all over the city and joyous people are filling the streets on their way to worship. So the curious Faust goes for a walk through the city among the jubilant Christians who are celebrating the Easter promise of new life, eternal life. His spirits are lifted and Faust knows the joy of faith, if only for a brief moment.

Although Faust later fell into the snares of the Evil One, on that one Easter morning he experienced the consolation of hope, the power of faith, and the joy of goodness animated by the Resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

In today's secular world many faithful Christians are confused about the role of religion in their life. Some are tempted to abandon their faith, or at least the practice of their faith. With many it is simple neglect: no prayer, no worship, no charity. Others just drift aimlessly without the anchor of faith. Still others have been crushed by human tragedies, or shocking scandal, or destructive relationships which can erode the hope and trust essential to faith. More commonly a certain malaise creeps into the spiritual life of many faithful Christians.

Most of us have inner struggles in our lives that are in need of new life. Many of our virtues and our values are dormant. We need new hope, new faith, new life. We need to rise by the grace of God to a new and fuller life here. Perhaps it is a troubled marriage, a family burden, a physical ailment, a failed relationship, a neglected faith. Too often we do not get to church, we do not give to our family, we do not generate goodness. At times we all suffer from spiritual doldrums. We endure a long spiritual "winter of discontent."

Fortunately, Spring returns. Church bells ring again. And never more joyously than on Easter Sunday. God's grace awakens the tepid, and never more ardently than at the Resurrection of the Lord. Easter defines Christianity and gives hope anew to sinners as well as to saints. The Easter promise is that I can do better. I can be a better person. I can be a better Christian.

Dr. Faust was curious about Christian joy on Easter, but he only visited Easter. Christians are to live Easter. St. Augustine said, "We are an Easter people, and 'Alleluia' is our song." "Alleluia," a composite of two Hebrew words, means "Praise God". Our Alleluia on Easter praises God for the gift of life; for new life, and renewed life; for spiritual life, and eternal life. On Easter we celebrate life.

"I am the resurrection and the life, whoever believes in me though he shall die will come to life: and whoever is alive and believes in me will never die."

**Christ is Risen.  
Christ is truly Risen !**

**Happy Easter**

**Alleluia.**

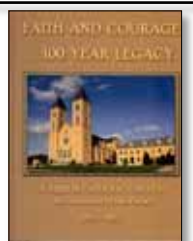

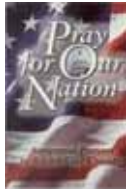
