# Priesthood Sunday

Today, October 29, is Priesthood Sunday. The mission and purpose is to celebrate and affirm the men who commit their lives to the Lord and the Church through the sacrament of Holy Orders. It is an opportunity for Catholic people to express their gratitude and share their love and support for priests. It also provides an occasion to promote vocations.

**“You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.  
This is the greatest and the first commandment.”**

(from the Holy Gospel according to Matthew 22:34-40)

Never one to shy away from controversy, Pope Francis riled a few feathers last year on the day before Halloween by talking about the reality of the devil and the need to take the power of demons seriously.

*“As Halloween drew near, Pope Francis warned that the Devil is real and must be fought ardently. The pope said that Christian life is a continuous battle against Satan. ‘This generation has been led to believe that the Devil is a myth, an idea of evil. But the Devil is real and we must fight against him.’ The Pope’s homily was based on Saint Paul who wrote that Christians must ‘put on the full armor of God’ to resist the temptations of the Devil. Francis urged listeners to have faith and not succumb to these temptations. He said no one can be a faithful Christian ‘without resisting temptation, without a fight against the Devil, without wearing this armor of God, who gives us strength and protects us.’”*

The above news report caused some to think that the pope was condemning the celebration of Halloween as satanic. Others saw it as a call to remake the celebration of Halloween as a fully Christian rite true to its historical origin. A few suggested changing the name to *Holyween* as a preparation for the celebration of the twin feasts of All Saints Day and All Souls Day. While these reactions are not totally without merit they do go beyond anything the pope has suggested or our Catholic tradition demands.



It is sad that our present observance of Halloween — All Hallow’s Eve, All Saints Day Eve — has lost all ties with its Christian origin. And that will be very difficult to recover. But it is irresponsible to claim that the celebration is now demonic. Perhaps

there is a rare gathering of a satanic cult at Halloween, but the celebration today is predominantly a chance for children to dream about what they would like to be, to dress accordingly, and to receive treats from friendly neighbors all in innocent fun. Our modern Halloween is a day for children to delight in their imaginations.

It can be more. We can teach children the Christian meaning of this day. It is the vigil of All Saints Day, a celebration of the great saints who should be our heroes and our models. It leads naturally to All Souls Day when we reflect prayerfully on those who have gone before us. That would truly be a Happy Halloween.

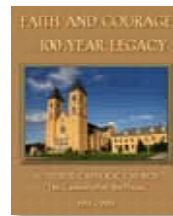
