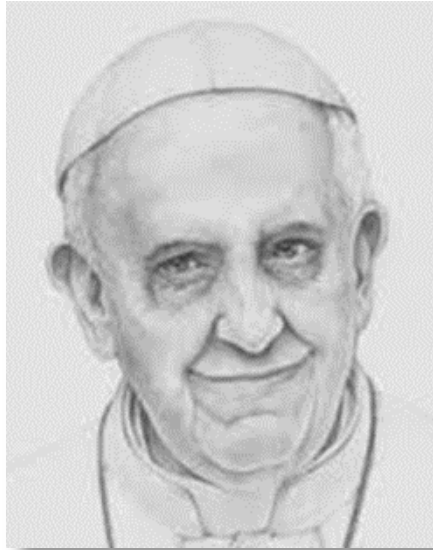
They were like sheep without a shepherd; and he began to teach them many things.

We resume with quotes from *Rejoice and be Glad*, Pope Francis' recent document on holiness in daily life. The full text is available online.

- “The saints were not odd and aloof, never unbearable because of their gloom and doom. Holiness is happiness.”
- “The saints do not waste energy complaining about the failings of others; they hold their tongue about the faults of others and avoid verbal violence.”
- “Christian joy is always accompanied by a sense of humor.”
- “The saints surprise and confound us because they urge us to abandon a dull mediocrity. Saints are creative.”
- “A community that cherishes the little details of love, whose members care for and welcome others, is a place where the risen Lord is present.”
- “Jesus explained with great simplicity what it means to be holy when he gave us the Eight Beatitudes in the Sermon on the Mount.”
- “I do not believe in holiness without prayer, a simple sincere prayer, neither lengthy nor of intense emotions.”
- “We should not think of the devil as a myth or a figure of speech. This mistake would let down our guard and make us more vulnerable.”
- “The devil does not need to possess us. He poisons us with the venom of hatred, envy, and vice which can destroy our lives and our families.”
- “Discernment is not about discovering what more we can get out of this life, but about recognizing how we can better accomplish our baptismal calling.”
- “We are frequently tempted to think that holiness is only for those who can withdraw from daily duties. The saints were extraordinary in the ordinary.”
- “Let us ask the Holy Spirit to pour out upon us a fervent longing to be saints for God’s greater glory, and let us encourage one another in this effort.”

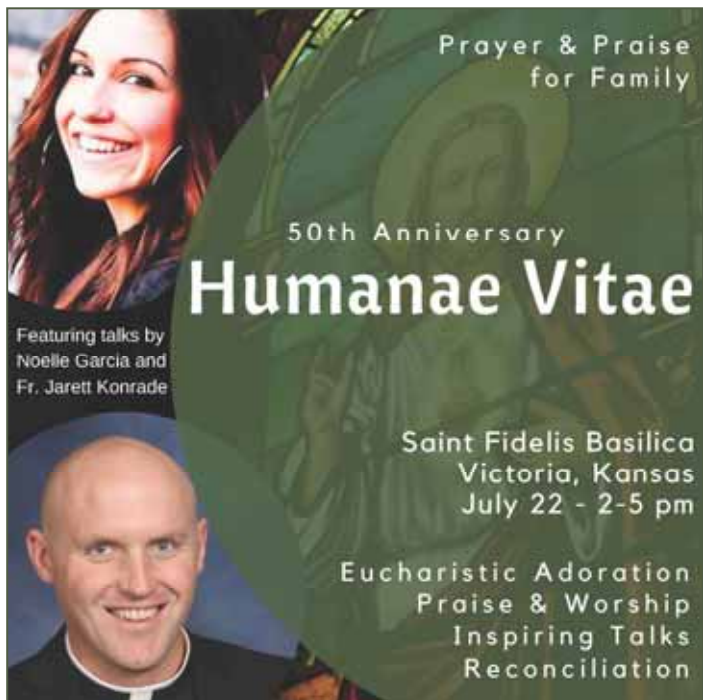

To obtain a plenary indulgence during a pilgrimage to a basilica, one must participate in any sacred rite or recite the Lord's Prayer or the profession of faith while there, then go to Confession and Communion and pray for the intention of the pope.
