And to work for a just society.**

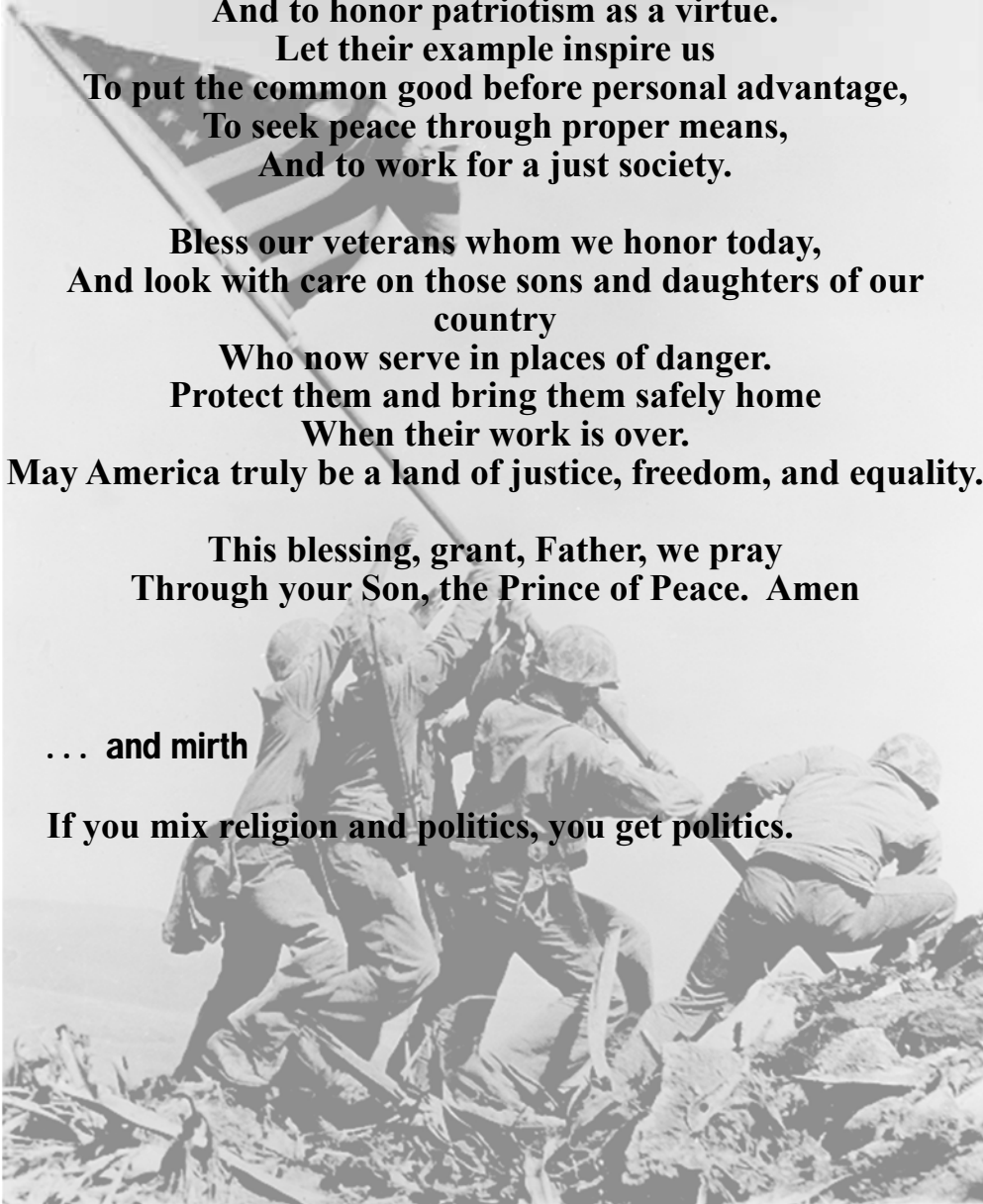
**Bless our veterans whom we honor today,
