

"TAKE IT; THIS IS MY BODY."

Mark 14:12-16, 22-26





Come Prepared

The gospel for this feast of Corpus Christi features the Last Supper, but it pays as much attention to the preparations as to the meal itself. We hear the word prepare three times. Jesus sends the disciples off with specific instructions to prepare. They went and did as told to prepare for their Last Supper with the Lord.

After the resurrection, when Jesus appeared to the disciples while they were fishing, he was waiting for them on the shore where he had already prepared a charcoal fire for the fish. The disciples came with the fish that they had just caught. They came prepared for a meal for which Jesus had already made

preparations. In our **Eucharist** celebration the Lord prepares a meal for us and asks us to come with hearts and minds prepared. The celebration of the Eucharist is a commemoration His life, death. and resurrection — the Paschal Mystery. The Last Supper celebrated his life given for our salvation. He asked his disciples to prepare for the celebration of that Last Supper, as he has prepared the gift he

In this Eucharistic meal of bread and wine he gives us himself: "Take it, this is my Body. This is my Blood." This simple menu is the only food that truly satisfies, for there is no greater love than to be offered the sacrifice of another's life. In this life we need to be nourished not only with food, but also with love and hope and care. In the Eucharist we share his divine life, we

would give them, the Eucharist of his

Body and Blood.

know his love, and we know that we are cared for, redeemed. He prepared a meal for us; we are to come prepared.

Our modern technology offers many helpful items, but they never completely satisfy. The Eucharist is our foretaste of the heavenly banquet, food for our journey towards eternal life and joy unending. A home and a meal nourish life and love. Today, you are invited to the table of the Lord in God's house. We are to come prepared

> for the sacred meal prepared for us.


